Happy New Year to you and your families.

It has been my pleasure this week to meet with students and staff through assemblies and our training day on Tuesday 2nd January. My key message was 'new = opportunity'. We looked at what is meant by Happy New Year – embracing the challenges before us and taking every opportunity to grow ourselves and others.

I based my message on 2 Corinthians 5:17, "Therefore if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here".

I shared how at the start of a new year, we have the opportunity to reflect on the last year and identify how we can be our better self this year.

We have the opportunity to have a fresh (new) start. I asked students to think ahead to the end of summer and imagine opening their end of term report – what will it say? How will they feel?
